Who is the Best Improver?

The best improver award is designed to focus on those starting out:

- Youngsters of any age or experience;
- Adult novices with up to 3 years experience;

A Best Improver will have some or all of the following characteristics:

- Have demonstrated significant improvement in their personal sailing over the season;
- Improvement may be at any level, for example:
 - has quickly understood and mastered the basics of sailing and moved on to mastering our sport;
 - simply beginning to participate in racing and doing well;
 - has significantly improved their sailing in some manner;
 - is beginning to make an impact on club racing
 - moved from winning club races to doing well in Open events or squads;

How to nominate someone

RULES FOR NOMINATION

1. Use the template overleaf to nominate someone for this award.
2. To make a nomination you must have been a member of KWSC during 2009.
3. The nominated person must have been a member of KWSC in the 2009 season.
4. You cannot nominate yourself but you may nominate a family member.
5. It is acceptable for us to receive several independent nominations for the same person.
6. Submissions must be received by 1st November 2009.

WHAT HAPPENS NEXT?

You should submit your nomination to the Committee via Steve Gibbon on either e-mail or by post (e-mail and postal address in the Year book).

The Committee will then consider all nominations and determine the Best Improver of the Year. The result will be announced at the Dinner Dance.
